

What Home-Group Leadership Isn't:

PREACHING

You do not need a seminary degree to lead a small group. You just need a heart to grow God's kingdom. The home-group setting is not a second sermon to follow the big corporate worship gathering. It is not a gathering of people to hear you lecture in a house. Rather, they came to talk and share and live life together. While you will read the passage that fits with the sermon plan and will field theological questions from time-to-time, it is not only permissible but strongly encouraged to forward questions you cannot yet answer to pastoral leadership.



What Home-Group Leadership Is:

LIVING LIFE BOOK-BY-BOOK

If we took time for in-depth discipleship, personal sharing, and Q&A after corporate worship each week; we would never beat the other churches to the restaurants in time. Home-Group is the time for people to share how they are applying their lives to the Bible text, ask questions, be invited to take their next steps, and be celebrated when they do. Churches that depend on their pastors to individually disciple every believer inevitably shrink and die. Churches that equip believers to do the work of ministry (Eph. 4:12) have no limit to their growth; reaching the community with the gospel. So, Home-Groups are the first line of defense when a group member needs some help and love while pastors are always on-call when needed across the whole congregation.

The Initial Launch of Home-Groups:

THE APPRENTICE

Prayerfully, actively, and constantly listen for the Holy Spirit's lead as he brings you "padawans." These are Jedis in training. Recruit them, explain to your group that they are getting ready to lead their own group, and even consider giving them a portion of your group if it grows too large. When your padawan becomes a Jedi, give them this presentation and direct them to the online Attendance Sheet to tell us about their group name, email contact, and attendance.
